Introduction: This policy is being updated to clarify driver’s license requirements and section title.

Effective with the issuance of this Special Order, Section 4-401 of the MPD Policy and Procedure Manual shall be amended as follows:

4-401 VEHICLE RESPONSIBILITY AND RESTRICTIONS/SEAT BELTS (07/26/02)

Employees who are authorized to drive MPD vehicles are responsible for the proper use and parking of vehicles assigned to them.

Police vehicles shall only be operated by authorized personnel in a safe and lawful manner. A valid Minnesota driver's license is required for anyone operating an MPD vehicle. (05/24/13)
