Introduction: This policy is being added to incorporate an item previously contained in 5-306. **SO20-017 for 5-306 was rescinded, so this Special Order was amended to show the change this update made to 5-306. This order was corrected to have the policy # 5-301.03 instead of 5-301.02.**

Effective with the issuance of this Special Order, Section 5-301.03 of the MPD Policy and Procedure Manual shall be amended as follows:

5-301.03 MEDICAL TREATMENT AND USE OF FORCE
(07/17/20)

Any sworn MPD employee who uses force shall, as soon as reasonably practical, determine if anyone was injured and render medical aid consistent with training and request Emergency Medical Service (EMS) if necessary (in accordance with P&P 7-350). Some force control options involve or require additional medical attention.
